- Assist with program assessment and evaluation tools
- Provide other program support, as needed

Time Allotted

This internship lasts one academic year. A minimum of 10 hours a week is preferred for this internship. This position is partially remote; students are expected to meet weekly with program leadership. Interns will participate in youth activities in person on designated weekdays and Saturdays.
